Hatfield Scholarships overview

Thanks to the generosity of alumni and friends of Hatfield College, the Hatfield Trust awards a range of undergraduate scholarships worth £4000 a year to support home-fee students from lower-income households to come to Hatfield each year. Students whose household income is less than £47200 per year are eligible to apply for a College UG scholarship. This is another commitment to support our vision of #AllOneHatfield.

The Hatfield Lioness PGT Scholarship and the Guy Beresford PGT Scholarships encompass #AllOneHatfield, one for a woman from a developing country and the other for a student from North East England doing a STEM degree. Our broad vision is only possible with support from alumni and friends who aid our students in pursuing opportunity and aspiration at Hatfield College through generous donations.

Miscellaneous Grants & Activities

- **RAMSAY BURN AWARD**

A scholarship to the value of approximately **£1200** awarded annually for a student to undertake a significant and aspirational musical development activity.

- **JUSTIN BROWNING HARDSHIP GRANTS**

Grants awarded at the discretion of College Officers to students of Hatfield College who meet unexpected financial difficulties or expenses affecting their ability to undertake or continue with their studies, either in the UK or abroad (including under exchange programmes), and which cannot be met by University hardship funds.

- **UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH INTERNSHIPS**

3-4 Internships awarded each year on a competitive basis to undergraduates at Hatfield College to gain experience by working on an existing research project, under the supervision of a Durham academic.

Estimated cost for 1 full internship for 6 weeks, paid at the living wage:
