<b>Boat club</b>	£20 Michaelmas term (access to the college gym*, coaching on land and on the water, tank sessions, an intercollegiate 'Novice Cup' race, and social events)  £35 a term afterwards as a senior rower	Opt-in	The boat club are interested in anyone who has rowed or coxed previously. It also runs a popular and successful novice program for anyone who hasn't rowed before. <p><b>Gowns</b></p>	<p>New Gown £50</p> <p>Second hand gown £35 (limited supply)</p> <p>The SJCR have a limited number of gowns which can be borrowed on occasion.</p>	<p>Opt-in</p>	<p>Gowns are worn for some college events, most notably the ceremonies of "matriculation" during Freshers' Week, where you will formally become part of part of the college and then of Durham University and some formal dinners.</p> <p>You will be given the opportunity to choose which type of gown you would like to purchase in the <a href="#">Key Information Form for Postgraduate Students 2025-26</a> which can also be found in your welcome packs. Payment will be taken on arrival via the SJCR.</p> <p>Please note that on graduation a different gown will need to be purchased/hired at an additional cost for the occasion. The University will provide further information on this closer to the time. On leaving College the SJCR run a 'buy back' scheme where they will buy back your gown for around £20.</p>
<p><b>Liver Out ASSA Key</b></p>	<p>£50 deposit</p>		<p>Students who are living out of college can request an ASSA key that will allow you entry to all the main doors into college. This can be paid at College Reception and will be refunded upon return of the key. Refunds can only be provided for a short period after graduation.</p>
<p><b>Room damages deposit (College residents only)</b></p>	<p>£100 refundable deposit</p>		<p>Included in accommodation invoice.</p> <p>Returned at end of academic year subject to satisfactory check of your room and the common areas on your floor/corridor.</p>

<p><b>Late payment of accommodation fees charge (College residents only)</b></p>	<p>£70</p>		<p>Our finance team may issue a late payment charge to a student's invoice, if communication is not made to indicate that there will be a delay on payment of residence fees.</p>
<p><b>Circuit Laundry App</b></p>	<p>£25 laundry code provided in October.  Additional £25 laundry code provided in May</p>	<p><b>College Residents only</b></p>	<p>College residents living in main college are provided with a £25 laundry code prior to arrival. Students typically choose a standard wash which costs £3 and drying is free. We recommend to download the circuit laundry app prior to your arrival: <a href="#">Circuit GO App or Tap</a>. The code can be uploaded on to the app or on the terminal in Cruddas A floor.</p> <p>Washing and drying machines are located on Cruddas A floor and Garth C floor.</p>
<p><b>Lost Room key fine (College residents only)</b></p> <p><b>Lost purple key fob</b></p>	<p>£50</p> <p>£5</p>		<p>A resident who loses their room key will be charged £50 which can be paid at College Reception, or our Finance team can raise an invoice</p> <p>Every room key will have a purple fob attached; this must not be removed. If lost or removed a fee of £5 will be charged.</p>
