

Certificate of Higher Education in Christian Ministry and Mission (180 credits) (V60346)

This programme is available at **South Central TEI**, in full-time and part-time modes of study. Within the parameters of the regulations set out below, students will negotiate their choice of modules with their tutor, in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or in which they are engaged, and module availability. Certain combinations of modules are excluded, as detailed in the module descriptors.

There are three methods of delivery:

In Person Learning ¹ – Tutor and student(s) in physical space together.

Online Learning ² – Interaction with tutor and fellow student on an IT platform.

Blended Learning ³ – Combination of In Person and Online.
